

Customer Information on the EU Packaging Regulation (PPWR)

11.08.2026

Dear Sir or Madam,

Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on packaging and packaging waste (PPWR) will come into force on **12 August 2026**.

We confirm that we will take the requirements of the PPWR that apply to our packaging into account from that date and ensure compliance with them within the bounds of our responsibility.

These include, in particular, the requirements for substances in packaging set out in **Article 5** of the **PPWR**, including the applicable limit values for lead, cadmium, mercury and hexavalent chromium.

The packaging supplied is not intended for contact with food. Therefore, the relevant regulations governing food contact do not apply. According to the information available to us, no PFAS are intentionally used or added during the manufacture of the packaging we supply or in the raw materials used.

The necessary information and supporting documents will be documented in accordance with the requirements of the PPWR. Where we are responsible for packaging as a producer within the meaning of the PPWR, the necessary technical documentation and the EU declaration of conformity will be drawn up and retained in accordance with Articles 38 and 39 of the PPWR.

Further requirements of the PPWR, which are not due to become mandatory until a later date, will be implemented in accordance with the relevant statutory transition periods.
